- Submit three work samples, which may be any combination of writing, photography, audio, video or social media posts/blogs. These may include essays written for class, work that appeared in a student publication or local media outlet. If you provide links to digital files, please be sure they all open properly.
- Complete the application form and attach a copy of your high school transcript with current GPA, one letter of reference and a one-page resume, including school-related or other activities.
- Write a 250-word essay on what Nebraska means to you.
