HOW TO APPLY:

- Be sure you're eligible. Graduate students must enroll for nine credit hours in the Fall 2023 semester; students who will be juniors or seniors in the Fall 2023 semester must be enrolled for 12 credit hours.
- Complete the scholarship application form.
- Provide three work samples, such as newspaper/magazine/web stories, photographs, audio or video clips, advertising copy or layouts or professional social media posts. If you provide links to digital files, please be sure they all open properly.
- Submit a personal letter outlining your goals and achievements. The letter must be no longer than one single-spaced page and will be a major factor considered by the scholarship committee. Be sure to proofread!
- Submit a letter of reference from an adviser or faculty member who can attest to your overall GPA and your GPA in your major and who can explain why you should be chosen for this scholarship. A second letter from someone of your choice is optional.
- Return all application materials to Mary Kay Quinlan, NPW Scholarship Chair, before the deadline of midnight, March 1, 2023, at npwscholarship@gmail.com. Late submissions will not be accepted.
